"CASE SUMMARY: SOCIAL HOST PARENTS NOT LIABLE AFTER BOOZY TEEN PARTY" RE-PUBLISHED BY QUICKSCRIBE REPORTER

A recent case summary co-authored by Harper Grey lawyers [Jaeda Lee](#) and [Steven Abramson](#) was re-published in the July 2020 edition of the Quickscribe Reporter.

Originally published to the Harper Grey Insurance Law Blog, "Case Summary: Social Host Parents Not Liable After Boozy Teen Party" discusses the decision in *McCormick v. Plambeck*, 2020 BCSC 881 ("McCormick"). In this case, the B.C. Supreme Court dismissed the plaintiff's claim that two parents owed him a duty of care as social hosts as he was a minor who attended their home in the presence of liquor and/or drugs.
