## "ARE CAR THIEVES BAD DRIVERS? REASONABLE FORESEEABILITY AND THE DECISION IN RANKIN'S GARAGE"

Harper Grey partner [Jonathan Meadows](#) and articling student [Dominic Wan](#) co-authored the article *Are Car Thieves Bad Drivers? Reasonable foreseeability and the Decision in Rankin's Garage*. The article originally produced for the CLEBC Nov 28 Insurance Law Conference, was recently republished in the 37 Can. J. Ins. L. – January 2019 edition of the Canadian Journal of Insurance Law.

In finding a duty of care was not established in this case, the court outlined the principles that should continue to guide courts in assessing whether a duty of care exists. This paper sets out the context in which these refinements were made and examines the clarifications outlined by the Supreme Court of Canada.
